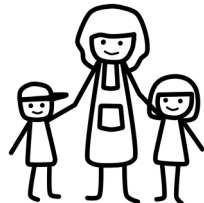
ROMP Mission Statement

ROMP Service Project:

This month, ROMP is supporting **Lovepacs**. Contributions may be brought to the main ROMP meeting. Lovepacs serves children on the free and reduced lunch program through area public schools. A direct relationship with school counselors and administrators has been established in order to properly identify children in need. Lovepacs provides mostly non-perishable, easy to open, and minimal cooking food items. In addition, it provides school counselors with stocked snack closets and hygiene products they may distribute to children who demonstrate a need

Lovepacs primarily serves children during extended school breaks when the food they receive from the local backpack program will not be enough. (E.g. Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring Break, Easter).
